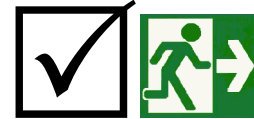


Politicians:



Job Done, or You're Gone!

Global Campaign for Political and Citizen Responsibility

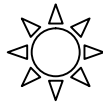
Political posts are like contracts for a some years mission job that candidates have signed with their employers: all of us, the voters, the citizenship...

... however, we haven't any effective mean for evaluating the job done. Voting every four years, has become a ritual manipulated by media. It just allows us to penalize some and to compensate others, among groups controlled by the most powerful.

Many statesmen do a remarkable work, but the lack of rules concerning the evaluation of the results encourage non-fulfillments and lies, is a focus for corrupt staff, and permits many other dishonest habits... in detriment of cooperation, accountability, transparency and responsibility.



On a world scale, globalization is widening the gap between the rich and the poor countries, between the haves and the have-nots, between the free and the gagged. State governments, acting like competitors on the market, are unable to coordinate to solve such disgraceful discrepancies.



From a political perspective, these are the two sides of the same coin, the two faces of a single problem:

An irresponsible, incomplete democracy, non-accountable to the people, non-adapted to globalization, not known where decisions are made, disrespectful of Human Rights, and unable to solve global injustices, not even national ones.

We need the automatic repeal of political positions, now, for a better democracy, for rights and justice for all!

What is the "automatic repeal" about? * After this mechanism will get approved, and before the elections, parties will assign **100 points to their election platform**, and distribute them among the different chapters (health, education, pensions...) at their convenience. **If the newly elected government does not keep its election promises** in the first year of its term, worth 85 points (specified for that period), it is given a warning. **If in the second year of its term it still has not fulfilled them**, it should resign and call new elections.

An **independent "Governance Tribunal"** made up of citizens chosen by draw and of civil-society actors will be in charge of supervising, through a transparent process and according to specific legislation, the interpretation and correct evaluation in every case.

But... what it helps for? and ... how it can get done?

What is this for?

⌘ **For more participatory, responsible, and open politics that will encourage human development and social justice. We, the citizens of each country, civil society, will be able to develop, partially or entirely, election platforms to match our true needs!**

- ▶ **International taxing (of finances and unused land and housing)**
- ▶ **Substantial cuts in military expenses**
- ▶ **Total debt cancellation and measures to change once and for all the conditions that generate debt in the poor countries.**
- ▶ **Reduction of tax avoidance with a global pact to abolish tax benefits in micro-states.**

Supported by these important **budgetary measures.**

This example concerns war and peace issues. We can ask for it to our candidates, in the next elections. In the web site you will find other examples on hunger, poverty, diseases, education, jobs, human rights, etc.

- ▶ **Declaration that war is a crime against humanity and trial of those who are responsible for it: politicians, the military, arms providers, financial actors**
- ▶ **Institution of a UN rapid intervention army and multiplication of civil dissuasion forces**
- ▶ **Progressive disarmament of weapons of mass destruction (nuclear, chemical, bacteriological) and of conventional armies.**
- ▶ **Conversion of the arms industries**
- ▶ **Help to countries at war or in a post-war period.**

How can politicians, even only those in a few countries, reach such ambitious goals? By making alliances among themselves, by lobbying for the democratization of the international institutions, by adopting measures simultaneously ("Simultaneous Policy"). We, the citizens, demand that they do. We want them not only to keep their promises nationally, but also to encourage international coordination in order to put an end to the excessive disparities of the global market. These are both related and have consequences on one another.

How can we do this?

By voting "usefully," from a social perspective! By waging this campaign, you and others like you, commit yourselves to vote for the party or candidate that will have accepted to include these points, as well as the "automatic repeal" mechanism.

We need to set up facilitation teams. The countries painted in green are going to have presidential or legislative elections in 2007 and 2008. **Our goal is to develop national platforms in each of these countries before 2007.**
